The following changes shall be included in the Plans and Specifications for the above referenced project, as prepared by Wightman & Associates, Inc. dated **April 2025**. This Addendum shall be deemed a part of the Contract Documents, and to the extent that the provisions of the other Contract Documents are in conflict herewith, this Addendum shall control.

## CLARIFICATIONS:

1. Question during prebid: Is Crushed concrete acceptable for compacted aggregate 53? Yes this material will be acceptable as long as it meets gradation.
2. All signs within limits of new pavement in the large lot shall be installed per the detail on the plans with the concrete foundation. Please note that there must be at least one sign per ADA stall, which is more than existing by approximately 2 signs.
3. The lot adjacent to the Student Activities Center, north of the Northside North Employee lot for reconstruction, will need to be accessible during the project. Coordination will be required with IUSB staff on phasing of the middle entrance to the lots during construction operations.

## SPECIFICATIONS:

1. Construction Fence detail was unintentionally omitted from the plans and specs and is included in this addendum.
2. An item for removal and replacement of existing curb and gutter at the direction of the IUSB staff or engineer in the field has been added to the list for unit price items on the bid form. It is anticipated that this is the straight curb per the detail on the plans.





TAX EXEMPTIONS

SUBSTITUTIONS

The undersigned Bidder has based his bid upon the materials, products, articles, equipment, brands, manufacturers and processes described in the Bidding Documents or upon approved equivalents. Proof of equivalency of substitutions is the responsibility of the Bidder, but the Architect/Engineer shall be the sole judge of equivalency. Proposed equivalent substitutions shall be equal in all respects to the requirements of the Bidding Documents, including but not limited to the design, quality, physical size, performance characteristics, strength, previous history of use, and to the method of installation, attachment, or connection to related or adjoining work. Determination of equivalency of proposed substitutions shall be by the Architect/Engineer, before the bid opening date, as described in paragraph entitled "Substitutions" in the Instructions to Bidders.

COMPLETION DATE

The Undersigned Bidder agrees to coordinate and expedite his work and shall take into consideration any lead time and schedule parameters with all contractors, and that this Work will be completed no later than **August 1, 2025**

ASSIGNMENT OF COORDINATION

The undersigned Bidder agrees to the assignment of Mechanical and Electrical work to the successful General Contractor for the responsibility of complete coordination of the work as stated in the Instructions to Bidders.

PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BOND

The undersigned Bidder agrees, if awarded the Contract, to deliver to the Owner a satisfactory Performance Bond, in the full amount (100%) of the total Contract price, not later than the date of execution of the contract. The cost of the Bond shall be included in the Lump Sum Base Bid contained in this Proposal.
