Proposed equivalent substitutions shall be equal in all respects to the requirements of the Bidding Documents, including but not limited to the design, quality, physical size, performance characteristics, strength, previous history of use, and to the method of installation, attachment, or connection to related or adjoining work. Determination of equivalency of proposed substitutions shall be by the Architect/Engineer, before the bid opening date, as described in paragraph entitled "Substitutions" in the Instructions to Bidders.

**COMPLETION DATE**

The Undersigned Bidder agrees to coordinate and expedite his work and shall take into consideration any lead time and schedule parameters with all contractors, and that this Work will be completed no later than August 1, 2025.

**ASSIGNMENT OF COORDINATION**

The undersigned Bidder agrees to the assignment of Mechanical and Electrical work to the successful General Contractor for the responsibility of complete coordination of the work as stated in the Instructions to Bidders.
