This addendum provides information to clarify or adjust construction items which may affect any or all trade contractors. PRE-BID MEETING SUMMARY

The following were questions raised at the Pre-Bid Meeting:

1. QUESTION: Confirm underground pipe type selection.
RESPONSE: The pipe selection provided in the documents has been confirmed as the desired selection for this project.
2. QUESTION: Will lockers require electrostatic painting on the interior and exterior?
RESPONSE: Yes, all lockers will require new electrostatic paint on the interior and exterior of the lockers. Existing devices (hooks, number plates, etc.) mounted on the lockers may be masked or removed/reinstalled.
3. QUESTION: Is additional scoping required at the end of the existing to remain lines after demolition?
RESPONSE: Additional scoping will be required at both ends of any removed section of piping to provide further information regarding the existing piping conditions in the areas outside of scope to ensure delivery of a flowing system at the end of the project.
4. QUESTION: What is the extent of existing duct painting on the project.
RESPONSE: All ceilings are to receive new P-5 finish. Ductwork in the shower areas to be sanded and prepped for new paint. New P-5 paint to be applied to all ductwork and piping in the shower areas. Refer to finish sheets and specifications for prep and new paint requirements.
5. QUESTION: Will a laydown area be provided?
RESPONSE: Contractor will have full access to the locker room areas during construction. There will be multiple construction projects happening at the facility during the same construction window as this project. The facility will remain operational during construction.
